



Maloff Protect

Uses

For chemoprophylaxis of *P. falciparum* malaria in adults, alongside bite prevention. Because Maloff Protect is effective against drug sensitive and drug resistant *P. falciparum* it is especially recommended for chemoprophylaxis of *P. falciparum* malaria where the pathogen may be resistant to other antimalarials. Official guidelines and local information on the prevalence of resistance to antimalarial drugs should be taken into consideration. Official guidelines will normally include World Health Organisation (WHO) and public health authorities' guidelines.

Dosage

Adults: 1 tablet daily taken at the same time each day with food or a milky drink (to ensure maximum absorption). Should not be crushed. Commence 1-2 days prior to entering a malaria-endemic area and continue during the period of the stay and for 7 days after leaving the area. Maximum use for up to 12 weeks. Not recommended in persons under 40kg of body weight. See SPC for contraindications, warnings, precautions and interactions.
